Aims of Course	The aim of the course is to obtain knowledge and skills in the area of English refining and petrochemical terminology.

Conditions of completion	<p>The course completion conditions are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – a student has to score min 16 points of max 30 points on each of two tests, – a student has to score min 3 points of max 5 points on each of two homework assignments, – a student can obtain additional 5 points for her/his excellent attitude during classes. <p>A student gets the following grades depending on the total point score: < 38 points – 2.0; 38 points – 45 points – 3.0; 46 points – 53 points – 3.5; 54 points – 61 points – 4.0; 62 points – 69 points – 4.5; 70 points – 75 points – 5.0.</p> <p>The grade of 2.0 is equivalent to non-completion of the course by a student.</p>
